
I will end by wishing you and your family a wonderful New Year! I hope to see you at a board meeting or a MST event next year!



**Proposed agenda for the election of 2022 officers** – The agenda for the Jan 11th 2022 meeting to elect officers was approved unanimously (Moved M. Haas / Seconded S. Lee)

**Election of Officers** – All officers with the exception of Vice President Whitney agreed to continue their current roles. Joe Lavender agreed to fill the vacancy of Vice President. A motion was made to renew the current officers with Joe Lavender filling the vacancy of Vice President (Moved S. Lee / Seconded M. Haas). The motion was approved unanimously.

### From the Editor

This is absolutely the worst time of year, especially for a Porsche sports car driver. Frigid temperatures, snow, ice, darkness, and salt incrusted roads do nothing to make me want to hit the highway. An occasionally sunny day helps a little. I have given up cross-country skiing after taking a painful fall a couple years ago, so that option for winter outdoor activity is out. Meanwhile my new Cayman GTS sits under cover in the garage. So, I must patiently wait for spring. I hope the current COVID spike eases off so that the club can hold some driving and social events when winter recedes.

On the Porsche news front the current top billing is a new Porsche AG publicity stunt. A Taycan 4 Cross Turismo drove from deep in the Eagle Mine in the western UP 15,889 feet to the summit of Pikes Peak CO. In the process a Guinness record for vertical distance traveled in one trip by an electric vehicle was set. Certainly, it was an endurance feat for the drivers, but what else it proved eludes me. Meanwhile certain facts about the trip were not revealed, to wit: how many recharging stops did it take to travel the 1,400 miles? The news release said "only the occasional recharge." The video I watched showed many more recharges than an "occasional." I am sure this drive was done at maximum speed, which would drain the battery quickly. What was the elapsed time of these recharges? I suspect we will never know. Anyway, an interesting feat, and good publicity for Porsche and Michigan, although impossible for an ordinary Porsche owner. We're not allowed to drive 1,774 deep into a UP mine.
