

Horsepower in Horse Country

The nineteenth annual Keeneland Concours d'Elegance will be held on July 16, 2022 in the heart of horse country, Lexington, Kentucky. The venue is the historic Keeneland Race Track. The Feature Marque will be **Porsche**. Four of the 20 judged classes will be Porsche. In addition, the PCA Bluegrass Region (BGS) will be holding a Porsche Hospitality Park inside the dedicated Car Club Paddock area. On the day prior to the concours, the BGS will also be hosting PCA Friday at Keeneland. PCA events this day will include a morning Concours Appreciation Training Session and an afternoon drive through horse country. Other activities available for visitors to enjoy include self-guided Walking Tours of the venue, visit to Gift Shop, observing Morning Thoroughbred Workouts, Meals at the Track Kitchen, Back Scenes of Concours site prep and the Keeneland Library. Schweinefiletring/Indiana Nurburgring Driving Tour August 6th, 2022



- The first **autocross** event this year will be held at **Birch Run Speedway** Saturday **July 9**th from 1:00-7:00. The reason for the later start is that a local sound abatement ordinance is in effect until 1 p.m. The track rental fee is \$900, double what we paid last year at Corrigan. Thus, the charge for driving in the autocross has changed to \$30 for PCA members and \$50 for nonmembers. Test drives were offered, but for those not driving there was plenty of car talk to be had as they roamed the lineup of member Porsches.
















Meeting adjourned at 7:32 (Moved S. Lee / Seconded D. Dickmann) approved unanimously.



From the Editor

I recently looked up membership numbers for Motor-Stadt Region for the past four years, and a plot of the data is striking. Beginning when I took over as editor of *Madness* in May 2018 until early summer 2020, the membership trend was on a slow decline. Then an inflection occurred (arrow). Since that time membership numbers have climbed steadily to record levels. What's going on?



The most obvious answer is the pandemic, although that still leaves some unanswered questions. The COVID lockdown began in March 2020. People then began to buy cars as the stock market strangely took off. Porsche N.A. new car sales jumped 22% from 2020 through 2021. Also, used car sales were way up. Sales during first quarter 2022, however, were down 25% as supply chain issues set in, the market tanked, and inflation began to be felt. Anyway, as people bought Porsches some have joined PCA and our club.

Another reason for our increased membership is strong support by the local dealership, Serra Porsche of Okemos. They include our three-fold promotional flyer, which was first published in 2020, with every car sale. Their brand-new, dazzling facility has been host to several club events since it opened in early 2020, which have promoted membership in Motor-Stadt.

Word of mouth probably also worked in our favor. As Porsche owners talk up the club new members are convinced to join. There may be other more obscure reasons, but I will leave you to think of them.
