






Horsepower in Horse Country

The nineteenth annual Keeneland Concours d'Elegance will be held on July 16, 2022 in the heart of horse country, Lexington, Kentucky. The venue is the historic Keeneland Race Track. The Feature Marque will be Porsche. Four of the 20 judged classes will be Porsche. In addition, the PCA Bluegrass Region (BGS) will be holding a Porsche Hospitality Park inside the dedicated Car Club Paddock area. On the day prior to the concours, the BGS will also be hosting PCA Friday at Keeneland. PCA events this day will include a morning Concours Appreciation Training Session and an afternoon drive through horse country. Other activities available for visitors to enjoy include self-guided Walking Tours of the venue, visit to Gift Shop, observing Morning Thoroughbred Workouts, Meals at the Track Kitchen, Back Scenes of Concours site prep and the Keeneland Library. Schweinefiletring/Indiana Nurburgring Driving Tour August 6th, 2022

Named the Schweinefiletring by locals, it's a series of roads strung together in southern Indiana that resemble Germany's Nürburgring in shape.



- Saturday, July 9. The first autocross this year will be held at Birch Run Speedway from 11:30-7:00. The reason for the later start is that a local sound abatement ordinance is in effect until 1 p.m. The track rental fee is \$900, double what we paid last year at Corrigan. Thus, the charge for driving in the autocross has changed to \$50, with a \$20 discount for PCA members. 



From the Editor

I love my new Cayman GTS. It is beautiful, luxurious, powerful, and handles fabulously, although I have not yet punched the pedal completely to the floor. That will be possible, however, during our first autocross of 2022 on July 9th at Birch Run Speedway. Why did I not order the equivalent Boxster? Well, because the hardtop Cayman seemed more durable, practical, and in my opinion it looks better. Besides, I also own a 993 911 Cabriolet for that wind-in-your-hair experience. Why own two convertibles in this climate?

I have a good friend, Irv (some of you have met him at our autocross events), who owns a beautiful 2002 Maldives blue BMW Z4 roadster. Often during warm weather we would take off together in our sports cars for top-down drives to some joint for lunch...the farther the better. Irv belonged to a motorcycle club for many years, and they would regularly embark for evening drives to some burger-and-beer place. So, Irv knew good non-local lunch spots. Often our spouses Kathleen and Judith would accompany us on these 993-Z4 jaunts, either to a restaurant or a picnic spot, always with the tops dropped. I look back fondly on these drives, both for the time spent with friends but also for the joint convertible experience.

Two and a half years ago Irv was felled by a massive stroke that left him permanently paralyzed on his entire right side and affected his speech. He is unable to walk and wheelchair bound. To add to his misfortune, his wife just died. The Z4 has been parked in a storage garage since the stroke and not driven. Our top-down days together are over. This unfortunate situation made me realize how important it is to share driving experiences with other people. Taking off in the 993 with the top down by myself is not entirely satisfying. I would rather do it with Kathleen, a friend, or a group of some kind. The feeling that you are on the road with other like-minded folks who share your passion for driving and people is the difference.

For this reason, I always try to participate in Motor-Stadt wheels-in-motion events, be they driving tours like this month's Jackson to Chelsea excursion, autocross contests, dinner drives, or Porsche on the Mac tours in the UP and northern Michigan. They are just plain fun. I encourage all of you to participate in these events. You will meet and socialize with great people and drive your car the way it was built to be driven. What's not to like about that? Yet for me, nothing will ever replace those those top-down drives with Irv.
