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





Proposed agenda – The agenda for the Nov 8th meeting approved unanimously (Moved D, Dickmann / Seconded S. Lee)

Meeting Minutes - The Oct 11th, 2022 board meeting minutes were approved via E-mail.

From the Editor

A few weeks ago, my wife Kathleen and I decided to take a drive in the Cayman GTS on a warm, sunny, Sunday afternoon. Where to go? We decided on MSU's Hidden Lake Gardens in the Irish Hills southeast of Jackson. How to get there? The direct route is Hwy 127 south to Jackson, then M50 east to the gardens. Direct—yes. Boring for a Porsche driver—yes. Taking my iPhone I plugged our destination into Apple Maps, which presented me three different routes, one of which looked to be just the ticket—lots of curvy back roads. So, I selected that route, plugged the phone into Apple CarPlay, and we were off.

The route took us east to M52, then south to Stockbridge. Thence we were routed southeast on various roads through Grass Lake, Napolean, and Brooklyn to M50. Finally, we drove past the Michigan International Speedway to Hidden Lake Gardens. Total time was about 1½ hours. The leaf colors were spectacular. Unfortunately, lots of other folks also were out for a drive on this magnificent day and the gardens were crowded. Nonetheless, the place is spacious and accommodating and well worth the drive, especially for anyone interested in botany or horticulture. Hiking trails infuse the area, so people easily become dispersed.

I have an interesting history with HLG. When I was on the faculty of the Department of Forestry at MSU I aided the crew from Kellogg Forest in doing several spring prescribed fires in a couple HLG prairie restorations. The burns were successful and all of them were contained. But because of COVID, a change in management at Kellogg Forest, and my retirement, the burns have been discontinued for several years. I hope they can be resumed soon.

Our return home was more straightforward than the earlier route: M50 east to M52, then north all the way through Manchester, Chelsea, and Stockbridge to Haslett Road and home. All in all, a thoroughly enjoyable day. We may live in the flatlands of Michigan, but that does not mean we have no interesting driving! Also note the report therein on the northern Michigan fall color tour. And there's still time to get some driving in before the snow flies.
