From the Editor

After four and a half years at the helm of *Motor-Stadt Madness*, I will hang up my spurs as editor of the newsletter as of this issue. I took over from the previous editor, Michelle O'Neil, in June 2018. As the newsletter format has evolved during my tenure, so has our club. Significantly, membership has grown in eye-popping fashion. Our total membership in June 2018 stood at 200 (primary + affiliate), but during several months through 2020 it dipped into the 180s. But in 2021 a surge of new members began joining the club, leading to a current membership of 261, with five new members alone joining this past month.

With the increase in membership, participation in Motor-Stadt activities has grown. I recall leading a driving tour to the Stahls Automotive Museum (a fabulous place) in Chesterfield, MI several years ago with three cars and three participants! This past year participation in driving tours leaped: our three tours in 2022 had 20-35 cars in each. In 2023 we began running at a much superior autocross track in Birch Run. Even though the driving distance to the track was longer for many participants, we still attracted a full compliment of cars during two events. In 2021 we held the well-attended Porsche-Corvette Autocross Challenge at Corrigan Oil Speedway (the Porsches won). Unfortunately, although enthusiasm on both sides was high, that track became unavailable to us, so another event was not held in 2022. But we hope to resurrect it at the Birch Run track. We held multi-region Porsche on the Mac events in St. Ignace in 2018 and 2021 (the 2020 event was cancelled due to COVID), with over 100 cars at the first and over 50 at the second. But this event will be no more because of lack of support by the St. Ignace Visitor's Bureau because too few cars were participating.

The above are just a few club highlights during my run as editor. Paula Zimmer, Customer Experience Specialist at Porsche Okemos, will take over as *Madness* editor in January of the new year. I am sure she will continue to produce a newsletter that is interesting and informative. I have thoroughly enjoyed putting these newsletters together. Thanks to all of you who have contributed to them over the years. I will end this edition of *Madness* by wishing you a joyous holiday season and the best in 2023. I will see you as a board member at Motor-Stadt events or as I hang around the Okemos Porsche dealership for some time to come.
