Proposed agenda – A motion to approve the agenda for the January 10th meeting was approved unanimously (Moved K. Jones / Seconded D. Dickmann)

Meeting Minutes - The December 13th, 2022 board meeting minutes were approved via E-mail.

Web Page and Social Media - James had uploaded new photos to the Motor-Stadt Region website along with an announcement made for the upcoming winter dinner. No new reports for the Facebook page.

Committee Reports / Activities:
