

The Brumos Collection: It's More Than a Collection, It's an Experience

In 1959, Brumos Porsche was formally established as a Porsche dealership. In the early 1960s, Brumos Racing became a force to be reckoned with. Brumos Racing and the #59 Porsches would dominate many races for decades.

Prior to 2015, there was an almost "secret museum" located within the Brumos Porsche dealership in Jacksonville, Florida. To view these special cars, you would need an invitation. This was not open to the public.

In 2016, the dealership was sold, but the name Brumos and the Brumos Racing franchise were not included. Thankfully, the extensive car collection was not included, either.

In 2020, the Brumos Collection opened their doors to the public in a beautiful brand-new building.

In March this year, my wife Renee and I got a chance to tour this awesome facility and see this collection of incredible cars. Here are a few photos. ~ Patrick Senters


