**Call to Order –** President Steve called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

**Approval of Agenda** – A motion to approve the agenda for the June 13<sup>th</sup> meeting was approved unanimously (Moved P. Zimmer / Seconded M. Haas)

**Meeting Minutes** – The May 9<sup>th</sup> board meeting minutes were previously approved via E-mail.

**Membership Report** – Steve delivered the membership report on Don's behalf. The club's current membership is 191 primaries, 89 affiliates (280 total) + 15 juniors.

**Treasurer's Report** – Mark delivered the treasurer's report. The club has \$11,653.60 in checking and \$8,039.82 in the investment account for a total of \$19,693.42. Some checks written for the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event have not yet cleared at the time of the treasurer's report. A motion to accept the report was made (Moved K. Jones / Seconded J. Lavender) approved unanimously.

**Advertising** – James delivered the advertising report. No major updates to report on.

**Insurance** – Joe delivered the insurance report. Insurance documentation for the Wilderness Driving Tour was submitted. Insurance approval was obtained for the June Autocross event (Motor-Stadt Autocross #1). Joe will soon submit a request for insurance approval for the July autocross event. Submissions for insurance approval are of no cost to the club.

**Newsletter** – Paula delivered the newsletter report and is gathering photos & other content from the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event for the newsletter's next issue.

**Web Page and Social Media** – James delivered the web page and social media report. Photos from the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event are being added to the club website in an event-specific gallery.

#### **Committee Reports / Activities:**

- Spring kickoff Steve reported that donation checks of \$1,550.50 were written to both the Greater Lansing Food Bank and the Food Bank of Eastern Michigan from the Spring Kickoff's charity auction proceeds.
- Wilderness Drive Joe reported that the Wilderness Drive event was successful with a turnout of 7 cars. Poor weather was a factor, but the group had a well-organized drive with new faces. It was reported that one of the first-time attendees signed up for the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event following the driving tour.
- 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration Steve reported on the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event. The club came in under budget, and a vote will tentatively be held next month to select a charity to donate an undetermined sum of money to later this year. There was a fender bender incident in the car show parking lot during parking. Details regarding the incident were submitted and accepted by PCA National. Steve had made attempts prior to the event to have someone representing PCA National in attendance to no avail. Feedback was provided stating members from other regions did not receive notice of the club's event despite Steve sharing the event's details with our neighboring region's board members. A motion to allow the club to reimburse board members for qualified expenses related to the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary event was made. (Moved J. Yen / Seconded P. Senters) approved unanimously.
- Autocross dates In preparation for the June 17<sup>th</sup> Autocross event (Motor-Stadt Autocross #1), a plan to request drivers volunteer where applicable when their group was not running was discussed. Paula volunteered to provide refreshments and snacks. Ken is to bring rental helmets and timing equipment. Set up to begin at 9:00 AM. The club's other 2023 autocross events are scheduled for June 29<sup>th</sup> & August 26<sup>th</sup>.

#### **New Business:**

- Next driving tour The board is tentatively looking to host the club's next driving tour on August 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Region Redbook Steve suggested the board gather all information it wishes to store in the Redbook before the July board meeting.

**Adjournment** - Meeting adjourned at 7:32 (Moved K. Jones / Seconded T. Whitney) approved unanimously.
