





# Motor-Stadt Region Joins PCA Version of IROC - History Part 3

The Motor-Stadt board and officers would like to extend our sincere thanks to Mark for his contributions made here in the club newsletter, and especially for his 50 years of club dedication and his part in forming the Motor-Stadt Region Porsche club into what it has become today for members old-and-new to enjoy for years to come. With our gratitude to you, Mark, we appreciate you.

- From your Motor-Stadt board and officers

In the August 2023 *Madness* newsletter edition, Part 2 of the MSR history story described some of the challenges the new board encountered and the success those efforts achieved. In this History Part 3, we take a look at MSR participation with other region clubs.

One of the more significant activities that Motor-Stadt participated in was a copycat race series named after the famed International Race of Champions (IROC) created by Roger Penske and Mark Donohue. It was immensely popular when it was established in 1973 as it brought the best race drivers in the world to race together in identically prepared race cars. The series in 1973 featured multi-colored Carrera 911 RSRs. The series was a huge success partly because it was televised nationwide.

Someone in nearby PCA-land had the idea to establish a multi-region autocross series. The idea was accepted and in 1974 Motor-Stadt, Western Michigan, and Michigan-Indiana formed such a series where each region would host one autocross during the season and the series would end with a major year-end awards banquet. It was also called the IROC series (Interregional Race of Champions).

Participants could earn trophies at each event throughout the year as well as a year-end trophy based on a cumulative point system. The series was popular and actually encouraged participation at events sponsored by the other regions. MSR member, mad scientist, Robert Sprafka, a physicist at MSU, created the complex point system. I believe only he knew how it all worked but no one dared challenge him. The series proved to be very



popular and was celebrated at the end of the season with a grand awards banquet bringing members of all three PCA regions together. Not only were individual members eligible for trophies but another award was created for the region that garnered the best participation. For at least one year (1978), Chicago Region PCA joined in the fun. MSR won the first-year region trophy. A tongue-in-cheek floating trophy was created, a large orange pylon adorned by an engraved plaque denoting the regional champion each year. I would like to know where that pylon now resides. Check out the photos provided to show the creativity and skill of the people who created these attractive trophies and awards.
