How I Bought My First Porsche

My love for Porsche began at the age of 20 after being a long-time Japanese car fan. In a world full of V8, V6, I6, and Turbo I4 engines, there is nothing quite like the NA flat 6 howl that comes from many of the most treasured Porsche models. I knew I needed one, so after finishing school and getting my first job outside of college, the search was on. The 987 Cayman and 996 Carrera were the two cars on my radar, but then, an unlikely contender entered the scene, the 986 Boxster.





Initially overlooked by many due to its controversial styling, interior quality, and being the 911's baby brother, the 986 went from being a car I never considered to the focus of my automotive desire. An affordable and reliable sports car with comparable chassis dynamics to the Cayman and a flat 6! How could I resist?

In March of 2022, I finally found 'the one'. A 1999 base model with the 2.5L in silver with a manual transmission. The car was purchased with 67k miles, and I am about to break 80k this month. I immediately got connected with MSR and started to learn about the world of HPDE. Later that summer, I went to my first-ever track day at GingerMan Raceway in South Haven, MI. In stock form, the car performed flawlessly, but I knew I needed more if I were to consistently attend track days and hone my skills as a driver. Track tires, a more aggressive brake pad, high-temperature brake fluid, and a rollbar extension were the bare minimum upgrades that were made.

Since the purchase of my Boxster less than 2 years ago, I've driven 15 track days and made every session with zero mechanical issues. It goes as a testament to these vehicles and their reliability if they are looked after and maintained diligently. I don't know what the future holds for my little Boxster. Part of me wants to move on to something bigger and better in the Porsche world, while another part of me wants to develop it into an all-out track toy. Whatever the fate of my Boxster may be, the 986 holds a special place in my heart as the car that got me into the Porsche brand and that has connected me with so many wonderful people inside and outside of the Club.
