

Terrill M. Whitney

March 26, 1932- September 6, 2025



WHITNEY, Terrill M. – of Chesaning, died Saturday September 6, 2025, at the Meadows of Owosso. He was 93 years of age. Terrill was born March 26, 1932, in Owosso to the late Leo and Gladys (Mason) Whitney. He was a resident of Chesaning most of his life. He was a 1950 graduate of Chesaning High School the attended MSU and SVSU and earned his teaching certificate. Terrill served in the US Air Force from 1955-1958. He retired from Chesaning Union Schools in 2001 with 30 years seniority. Mr. Whitney attended Trinity United Methodist Church, Terrill was an avid Porsche enthusiast. He belonged to the Porsche Club of America, Motor Stadt Region of Michigan for 32 years, he was the Motor-Stadt Club President from 2006-2007 and enjoyed driving different model cars. 





<u>Membership Report</u> – James Yen & Steve Lee delivered the Membership Report. The club has 187 Primary members, 86 Affiliate members for a total of 273 members.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – James Yen delivered the Treasurer's Report. The club has \$8,422.32 in checking and \$10,966.27 in the investment account for a total of \$19,388.59. The treasurer's report was accepted unanimously (Moved S. Lee / Seconded K. Jones).

<u>Advertising</u> – Piotr Pawlak reported that no advertising check was received from OS&K for 2025 advertising. Invoices for 2026 Advertising are projected to be sent in October.

Insurance – Joe Lavender reported insurance for the Dinner Drive was obtained.

<u>Newsletter</u> – Beth Rogers reported that the September newsletter is nearly ready for publication.

<u>Web Page and Social Media</u> – James Yen reported efforts are being made to create and implement custom email addresses for specified chair positions.

Committee Reports/Activities:

- **Dinner Drive 9/11 –** Curtis Howe reported 10 cars had registered
- Rocket Launch 10/4 Curtis Howe reported 1 additional member had registered
- Fall Color Tour 10/18 Paula Zimmer informed the board that the dealership plans to assist in organizing a drive event with the help of MSR. This will be an event jointly run by the club with a proposed starting time of 10:00 at the dealership, light refreshments, and a drive to Cottage Creek Orchard. The total duration of the event will be between 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM. Curtis Howe and Dave Rogers are connecting to review a route and confirm availability with the Orchard.

- Future Board Meeting Locations It was decided that The Club's monthly meetings will continue to be held at Spag's Bar and Grill in Williamston.
- **Equipment Storage** Steve Lee & Nathan Traxler are in contact regarding desired trailer specifications.
- Terrill Whitney Passing The board was informed of Terrill Whiney's recent passing.
 Terrill served as MSR Club President in 2006-2007 and was a member of the club for 32 years. Notice of his Visitation and Funeral were shared
